INTERNATIONAL ADVANCED EDUCATION IN GENERAL DENTISTRY (IAEGD) RESIDENCY PROGRAM

Case Western Reserve School of Dental Medicine (CWRU) in Cleveland, Ohio, USA and the School of Graduate Dentistry at Rambam HCC in Haifa, Israel are proud to announce the new joint International Advanced Education in General Dentistry (iAEGD) program.

The Mission of the program is to provide outstanding postgraduate training in oral health, patient care, and research. This will be accomplished in an environment which fosters academic achievements, collegiality and professionalism. The iAEGD program provides the resident the opportunity to deliver the highest quality of comprehensive dental care to the broadest range of the patient population, with considerable experience in implantology and full mouth rehabilitation.

Two candidates who will be accepted in the program will begin the first preparatory year at the Rambam Health Care Campus in Israel; following successful completion of the academic requirements and clinic competencies at Rambam, the residents will begin a two year accredited AEGD program at CWRU in the United States. At both institutions the didactic and clinical training will be in English.

The program will begin August 1st, 2013 and applications should be submitted no later than February 28, 2013. Selected applicants will be interviewed by April 2013.

According with the current state regulations, residents who successfully complete the program may be eligible to take the board exams towards a dental license in Ohio, USA. (see <http://www.dental.ohio.gov/licensinginfo.stm#foreign>)
